Re: 125cc 2 Stroke / 250cc 4 Stroke Machines

As you would be aware under the new Junior Coaching Program all riders who wish to compete on either 125cc 2 Stroke or 250cc 4 Stroke machines must complete 5 hours of coaching on each machine prior to being endorsed to ride it.

All riders who have competed on either of these machines prior to 1st July 2006 may complete a Statutory Declaration (attached) confirming their current experience competing on these machines. By completing this Statutory Declaration you are declaring that prior to 1st July 2006 you have competed, not practiced, on either machine and therefore the pre requisite of 5 hours coaching on that machine is no longer applicable.

Please note that a rider who is endorsed for 125cc 2 Stroke must received separate endorsement for a 250cc 4 Stroke and vice versa. Also note one capacity machine to one form, if you are currently competing on both machines you will be required to complete two separate forms.

For all riders who have competed prior to 1st July 2006, please complete the attached form and return to the MNSW office **by Friday 1st September 2006.**

The attached form must be completed by the rider or parent/guardian and must detail the last MA permitted meeting at which you competed on either a 125cc 2 Stroke or 250cc 4 Stroke machine. The meeting information must be completed for the declaration to be accepted. This form must also be signed and verified by either a Steward, Clerk of Course, Race Secretary or Club Secretary.

Please note that this is a legal document that may affect your rights. Read it carefully and do not sign it unless you understand it. Any false declaration may result in penalties being issued. All declarations submitted will be checked for authenticity.

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Junior 125cc / 250cc Statutory Declaration Form

The General Competition Rules of Motorcycling Australia outline the Junior Coaching Program, which requires that competitors on a 125cc 2 Stroke or 250cc 4 Stroke machine must have completed 5 hours of coaching on each machine. In the initial year of operation, riders competing on these machines prior to the introduction of the Junior Coaching Program on 1st July 2006 will be deemed to have completed the required 5 hours coaching. Riders competing on these machines on or after the 1st July 2006 will be required to show proof of 5 hours coaching on their machine before being permitted to compete. Only riders who have actually competed (not practiced) prior to the 1st July 2006 will be eligible to complete this declaration. Riders, if requested will need to prove competition experience.
